1. The Bible has 66 Books, 1,189 Chapters, 31,102 verses, 773,693 Words and 3,566,480 Letters.
2. It was written over a period of 1,800 years.
3. The longest chapter is Psalm 119 which has 176 verses. (the multiplication numbers for 176 is 16x11)
4. The shortest chapter is Psalm 8:9
5. Esther 8:9 is the longest verse and John 11:35 is the shortest verse.
6. The middle verse in the Bible is Psalm 118:8 and "the Lord" is the two middle words in that verse.
